singing or praying.

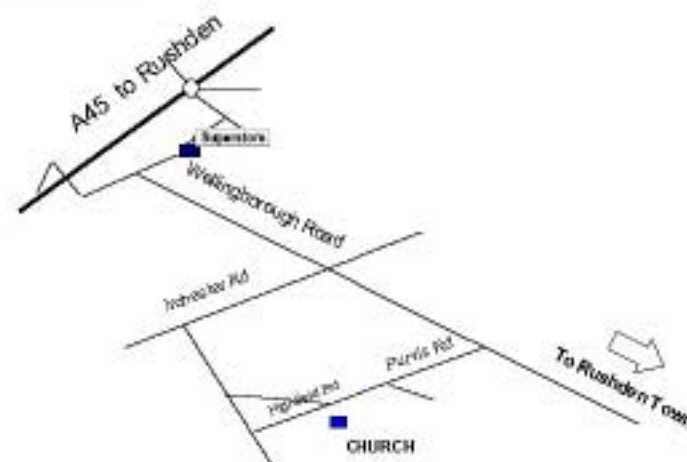
Come and enjoy something o

The Highfield Improvement Project was established in 2005. The long term plan is to develop the area socially, educationally, environmentally and

Highfield Church is used as a base for the project. From here a drop in coffee shop has been established on a Tuesday morning to cater for local people and provide advice, guidance and information on various subjects. Also a community association has been formed. This runs various events throughout the year to help and involve the community.



In 2004 HCLC was started at the request of Adult Learning Services.

Highfield Community Learning Centre is a community based and managed facility bringing a wide range of activities.

The centre is supported by the Church, Northamptonshire County Council, Rushden Town Council, and East Northamptonshire Council.
